MINUTES BOARD OF DIRECTORS GONZALES CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT June 11, 2025

The Board of Directors of the Gonzales Central Appraisal District met on Wednesday, June 11, 2025 at the appraisal district office located at 301 St. Joseph Street, Suite A, Gonzales, Texas. Board members present were Bud Box, Josh Gray, D'Anna Robinson and Jeff Harvey. Also present were John Liford; Chief Appraiser, Nick Rapoza; Deputy Chief Appraiser, and Lisa Pakebusch; Recording Secretary.

Bud Box, Vice-Chairman declared a quorum and called the meeting to order.

The minutes of the May 22, 2025 board meeting were approved upon motion by D'Anna Robinson and seconded by Jeff Harvey. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

The financial report for the month of May was reviewed with the Board reflecting the district was under budget year to date by \$252,857.34. Jeff Harvey motioned to approve the financial report as presented. The motion was seconded by Josh Gray and passed by unanimous vote.

Josh Gray reported that all checks presented have been signed.

There were no Public Comments.

D'Anna Robinson motioned to adopt Resolution No. 414, approving the Texas County and District Retirement System plan provisions for the plan year 2026 with the 16% contribution rate remaining the same but changing to 8 years of services to be vested, at any age with 20 years of service, and the employer match of 250% future only with no cost-of-living adjustments for the plan year 2026. The motion was seconded by Josh Gray and passed by unanimous vote.

Mr. Liford presented an adjusted proposed budget for 2026 including financials for the building of a new office for the appraisal district. After discussion D'Anna Robinson motioned to table the public hearing and set the new public hearing date as July 24, 2025 so that the adjusted proposed budget for 2026 can be mailed out to all the entities. The motion was seconded by Jeff Harvey and passed by unanimous vote.

Mr. Liford reported that the ARB hearings are still in progress. Mr. Liford reported that the district is still receiving Homestead and Ag applications and that there was no educational training to report on at this time.

As there was no further business at this time, Josh Gray motioned to adjourn. The motion was seconded by D'Anna Robinson and passed by unanimous vote.
